### **Newbold Verdon Parish council Grants criteria**

Newbold Verdon Parish Council has a small budget for the award of grants to the community. Newbold Verdon Parish Council Grant Scheme aim is to support and promote an active community within the Parish. The Parish Council recognises and supports the valuable contribution made by the voluntary sector to the wellbeing of the community. We aim to improve the range of services and activities in the parish. Applicants must return a full application form when applying for a grant. Application forms are available from the Parish Council office, Sports Pavilion, Alans Way, Newbold Verdon, LE9 9LB or via e mail request to the clerk at [clerk@newboldverdonpc.org.uk](mailto:clerk@newboldverdonpc.org.uk).

The deadline for applications is the 19<sup>th</sup> August annually.

The maximum amount that can be applied for is £500.00.

If you are successfully awarded a grant Newbold Verdon Parish council will not consider another application from your organisation for 3 years from the date your current grant is paid.

#### **Terms and conditions:**

- The amount of the award will be at the Councils sole discretion.
- All applications will be considered on their merits.
- The application must be from a genuine community group or organisation ideally based within Newbold Verdon.
- The grant must be for the benefit of residents in Newbold Verdon Parish. Where the applicant is based outside the Parish then any grant payable shall be based on the assumed proportionate benefit to be gained under the funded scheme/project by Parish residents.
- A list of other sources of finance being sought should be provided.
- The grant applied for is within the agreed Parish Budget and the council has the power to use its money for this purpose.
- The grant must be used to:
  - a) promote group activities within Newbold Verdon and/or
  - b) provide a service to residents of Newbold Verdon.
- When the grant is paid the funding must still be required for the same purpose as that described in the application .
- Grants are subject to satisfactory completion of a full application form detailing the scheme/project and costs.
- Unless approved by the Council If the grant is used for any other purpose than that for which it is awarded then the grant shall become immediately due and repayable.
- A short report on how the grant was used and benefitted the scheme/project will be required. Criteria by which applications will be assessed.

No grant monies shall be used directly or indirectly for any immoral or unlawful purpose or for any matter which may cause offence or bring the council into any potential disrepute.
